This means that we are giving our most vulnerable children the very best possible start that they can have. This is only possible with the dedicated, warm, positive and caring staff team that always go above and beyond for the children. I am so very proud of what we do here and I am sure you are too! Above all things we are a kind and caring school, treating every child as an individual and ensuring equity of provision for all.

We are also lucky enough to have a very kind and selfless group of parents that make up FOKS. I know I have mentioned them every week I think so far, but we really cannot thank them enough for everything they do for the school. They have lots of plans in place for so many extra things to support the education and joy of our children. Not only are they making over the KS1 space, but they have Christmas plans and plans all year round! To all the members another huge thank you for your kindness and for all the hard work you do. FOKS have now got a space on the school website to share information and all the wonderful things coming up, and this will be populated over the next few weeks. Each week we give out certificates for the children to celebrate their achievements – reading or our Lighthouse keepers. Each week I express how proud I am of these award winners, however this week the winner really, really made myself and the school staff quite emotional! We have a diverse intake of children who have many additional needs. We try to support each one with whatever they need. Sometimes this means that children can be sad, angry, upset and in lots of schools around the country this leads to children with additional needs being ostracised and having fewer friendships as some school communities are not as accepting. Here we absolutely strive for ALL of our children to feel loved and belong to our community. This week Frax supported a child who was really struggling and really distressed, showing huge kindness, care and love for one of his peers. His actions have made me so very proud of him, and proud of the values our school is teaching and seeing in action.

I truly believe that thanks to all of our community, we have the best school around!
