Dear parents/carers and families,

We have had a wonderful week back to school after half term. The children are so positive and it has been really wonderful to see them focusing so hard on their learning. This week we have had two Headteachers from other small schools in the trust to visit and look at what we are doing. They were incredibly impressed with our school, our children and our approach in particular to learning, inclusion and additional needs. They commented how caring and polite the children were, and how joyfully they spoke about their learning. I was ever so proud of the children and staff. In turn, I spent some time at their schools and it has been lovely to see how other communities, in a similar size and situation to ourselves, do things. It has given me lots of food for thought!

We also have some incredible good news. Our amazing PTA, FOKS (Friends of Kehelland School) have worked incredibly hard and managed to win a grant of just over £21,000 to spend on play equipment. We are all so very excited and we will soon be using the money to support the children. An absolutely massive thank you to FOKS, and in particular Jenny Olds (Tam and Jack's mum!) for her perseverance and the time she has put into it. With this in mind, I am a real believer in the children being outside and playing as much as possible! We have found that when we developed a rota and introduced new activities at playtimes, the children were better prepared and happier in their learning during the day. For this to be successful, we will be encouraging children to go outside in all weathers and on the field. Therefore, PLEASE send your child into school with a pair of wellies that can be left on site, for the days when they are needed. Additionally, if you have spare wellies at home you would like to donate to the school, please send them in! Let us know they are a donation, so that we don't try and send them home to you at the end of term!! To help us with this, the ever brilliant FOKS are looking into supplying waterproofs for the children - more on this to follow!

Finally, can I please remind you all that any children that arrive late, need to come to the office WITH a parent/carer who needs to sign them in. This is for safeguarding purposes. Please do not drop them at the front gate and leave. Other start of term reminders — please send your child with a suitable coat each day, their PE kit on PE days including footwear as we will ring home for you to bring it in if we do not have it.
