SATS do not show what amazing people our year 6's are. They do not show their humour, kindness and enthusiasm. They don't showcase their hobbies, talents and skills in areas they love. They don't have a bearing on how wonderful your child is. The academic side of things are not the most important. The most important thing is that they are happy and know they are loved. I hope the children realise we will not think any less of them if they have a bad day, similarly if it makes them happy to do well and excel at the SATS then I know they will. For some children the SATS are great, but for those that it isn't great, that is absolutely ok too. None of them will "fail" because in our eyes they will never "fail" and it will not affect their future or secondary school. They must not think that the SATS are the end of everything – please, please this weekend encourage them to have a go....but to not worry or be nervous. I know every one of our year 6 children are awesome and we love them very much!

I do hope the sunny weather continues over the weekend, and I hope that you can all make the most of the sunshine and outdoors. It is I believe the Kehelland Trust Orchard Blossom and Wildlife weekend – if you have booked tickets do enjoy this and ask your children to do a wonderful Maypole dance demonstration...they really impressed us with their dance skills this week!
