Reception Why is Easter special to Christians? F3

Week 1 New life. Explore signs of new life in plants outdoors. Look at videos/photos of chicks, baby animals.

Week 2 Link Winter/dead plants and arrival of Spring with Christian Lent and Easter. Palm Sunday story.

Week 3 Palm Sunday traditions in Christian church- palm crosses, processions, hymns.

Week 4 Good Friday- Creation of Easter Garden.

Week 5 Easter. Christian belief that Jesus came back to life.

Week 6 Christian and secular celebrations at Easter time.

Y1/Y2 Why does Easter matter to Christians? L1.5

Week 1 Events of Holy week set up as a time line with key objects. Emotions of followers identified. Palm Sunday-palm leaves, donkey. Joyful.

Week 2 Last supper- cup and bread. Solemn. Puzzled.

Week 3 Jesus' arrest. Fear. Shock.

Week 4 Good Friday events. Fear. Grief.

Week 5 Easter Sunday. Joy. Amazement.

Week 6 Salvation- Jesus showing followers that new life possible after death.

Week 1 Discuss meaning of Salvation. Recap events of Holy Week from Mary's perspective, writing diary entries. Palm Sunday. Plot on emotion graph. Celebration of Palm Sunday by Christians.

Week 2 Jesus' arrest and crucifixion. Mary's diary entry. Plot on emotion graph. Remembrance by Christians (Lent, bare churches, vigil, stations of the cross). BBC Two - My Life, My Religion, Christianity, Easter

Week 3 Easter Sunday- resurrection. Mary's diary entry. Plot on emotion graph. Discuss change from Friday to Sunday. Celebration of Easter by Christians. <u>BBC Two - My Life, My Religion, Christianity, Easter</u>

Week 4 Discuss how a Christian's journey through Holy Week mirrors the events and emotions at the time. Write three diary entries that a Christian might make for Holy Week. Palm Sunday. Good Friday. Easter Day.

Week 5 Return to discussion of Salvation. Why was it Good that Jesus died? What was God showing people through his son?

Week 6 Recap. Compare Christian and secular celebration of Easter. Similarities and differences.

Week 1 Recap events of Holy Week, using Bible extracts and artwork. https://www.jesus-story.net/

Week 2 Who was responsible for Jesus' death? Romans, crowds, Pilate, Jewish leaders, God, Jesus? Present as a debate.

Week 3 Consider Jesus' death as a sacrifice, taking on the sins of the world and providing redemption. How do Christians feel and react to the belief that Jesus died for them? The Last Supper and Christian communion- the symbolism of the bread and wine. (Differing beliefs amongst Christians- Roman Catholic transubstantiation).

Week 4 Discuss how some people are prepared to make sacrifices for their beliefs, even if they die. https://bit.ly/2lrOQCP Choose one example person to discuss in detail.

Week 5 Discuss how sacrifice in daily life involves giving up time, money or activities. What might they be prepared to give up and for what cause? Giving What We Can Community: Maximise your charitable impact · Giving What We Can

Week 6 Draft a charter for the school/community/world to explain how we should act to make it a better place. Link with idea of sacrifice.
