Dear parents/carers and families,

This week I have been incredibly impressed with the high standard of learning happening in our classrooms. As part of our new curriculum, and to check that our teaching and learning are of the highest quality, staff regularly meet and look at the children's books together. It is evident from the books that they are all working incredibly hard and understanding how important learning is. One of the best bits of being a Head teacher, is when teachers bring children to my office to celebrate their incredible learning. This week I have seen many children, looked at their incredible work and awarded many stickers and congratulations! All children are different and their best should always be celebrated, but in particular, this week the high standard of presentation has really impressed me. Please do continue to remind your children how important excellent presentation in their books is, and tell them we really do notice those children trying their very best every day. We have several weeks left of the year and the children and teachers will be using this time wisely to ensure that all children can achieve their best learning outcomes.

I will, in the next couple of weeks be looking at attendance figures for the summer term. Can I please gently remind you that regular attendance at school is a legal requirement as set by the government and Department for Education. Our parent guide to attendance is on our website for more information, but children should have an attendance of 96% or more. Anything below 90% the government classes as "persistent absence" and may result in absences (even for genuine illness) being marked as unauthorised without medical evidence of illness. The local authority will then fine parents for these unauthorised absences – just to note the school does not receive the fine monies! I will work with all parents to manage absences, we do understand genuine illness, however, the law is very clear and we have to follow the legal guidelines set out. It is a very tricky thing to manage – as a parent myself and as a Head teacher.

I am aware that the hot weather is due to break down this weekend. However, please can I ask you to make sure that your child is prepared for the weather in school each day – sun cream and hats if hot, raincoats if rainy! This will be particularly important next week for our fantastic Sports Day! I always look forward to this event and I am quite grateful that it is taking place next week when the forecast is fine, but slightly cooler than it has been this week. We look forward to seeing you all there – dates and times in the calendar section of the newsletter.
