Dear parents/carers and families,

The children have done such a wonderful job of settling in to their new classes and the new structure of the day. We had our first proper certificate assembly of the year this morning, and I have to be honest and say that it really is my favourite part of the week. I am sure the children think I am completely nuts, as we drum roll and cheer for our certificate winners! However, it is really important that they remember that school is a joyful place where we all work together to make wonderful memories and to celebrate the good that the children do. I am so often surprised when schools do not make joy and memories a priority for their children and their community – yes the academic is super important, but so is the wellbeing of our whole community. That has to come first before the academic falls into place.

This week I have asked the children to stop thinking about being "rubbish" at a subject, in assembly several people said they were "rubbish" at maths in particular. As adults in school, we often hear that children have decided that they simply can't do a subject. This causes huge issues, and often the label they have given themselves hinders them more than their actual ability – which is usually pretty good despite their perception! Please can you encourage them to see that learning is a process, and even if you struggle with a subject, it doesn't mean you are rubbish. It just means you have to keep going, and do YOUR best. Stop comparing yourself to others and just work on improving your skills – 1% improvement is still an improvement. Learning is about the journey and not the destination!

This week the children have been very lucky to have FOKS member Becky (Frax's Mum!) come in and create vegetable creatures ready for the Horticultural Centres Giant Veg competition in the village tomorrow. The creations were fantastic and they all had a wonderful time. It really helped fine motor skills, imagination and gave a great injection of joy and memory making into the week. A huge thank you to Becky who single handily organised and prepped the amazing creations. We will be advertising and publicising lots of local events over the year and we would encourage you and your families to attend and join in with the events as they really are so valuable to the development of each child, their memories, family time and our community as a whole. Our FOKS (Friends of Kehelland Village School) group are a small but caring and might group, who do so very much for our school, children and community. Please do volunteer your time or skills — even if it is just a little thing you can do, because what they do is absolutely amazing. We really are all a team and we need as many people as possible to make our little school great!
