Dear parents/carers and families,

Happy New Year – welcome back to school, Spring Term 2024. It has been a wonderful week, especially being able to share the official Ofsted report and outcome with you all. Thank you for all of your lovely emails, messages and chats of congratulations. It really was a wonderful team effort, and we are very proud of what Team Kehelland has achieved!

This term is going to be another fun packed one! To let people know that have recently joined our community and refresh everyone else can I just let you all know about the following:

- Newsletters go out on a Friday, via email and they are put on the website each week too, so that you can go back and see them if you miss it. Lots of important information is in the newsletter and we would really appreciate it if you could read it each week. We will start to put a link to the newsletters on the website on Facebook each week as well.
- After school clubs (arts, sports, construction, SATS etc) are booked each half term, Miss Young gets bookings and club lists and sends these out to parents via email before the end of the preceding term so on return you all know which clubs your child is in. They are first come first served and booked via email. We keep an eye on the list so that all children get a chance to do the club over the year if clubs are very popular.
- After school and breakfast club wraparound childcare MUST be booked at least a week in advance. This is really important, because we have to adhere to particular ratios for safeguarding purposes. These ratios depend on the age of the children attending. Sometimes we need 2 or 3 members of staff, and without prior warning we cannot do this. In absolute emergencies we will always do our best to look after children, but please help us by ensuring as much notice as possible.
- It is really important that we have the correct email address for parents – please check your junk and other inboxes just in case our emails go in there.
- Please don't allow your children to bring in toys or fidgets. This is because they cause lots of arguments and upset. Also, some toys like "squishies" often burst and the contents are not always hypoallergenic etc, potentially causing issues.
- Office emails are checked week days between 8am and 3.45pm during term time. Class teachers have email addresses and Seesaw messages to contact them on, but they check these between 7am and 6pm during term time. Please be aware that if you email the office after 3.45pm you will not get a response by the next morning, but we will do our best to get back to you ASAP. If you have an emergency please ring the school as this is the best way to get hold of us quickly.
