Dear parents/carers and families,

Welcome back to the second half of the summer term! I cannot believe we are in the final part of the year – it has just flown by! There are an awful lot of dates, activities and amazing things planned during this part of the year – as there are every year – but please do keep an eye on the dates section of the newsletter, Seesaw, ParentPay and emails to make sure you are up to date.

We gave been so very lucky with the wonderful weather, but please do remember to send your child in with suncream applied and with a hat and a water bottle. Please only put water in the water bottle. It would also be helpful if you could check and make sure that your child has the correct PE kit in school so that teachers can take advantage of the fantastic weather, and if needed can do extra sport's day lessons for example. Now I have made so much of the great weather I am sure we will have rain soon......the British weather is always quite contrary like that!

We have been spending time in assemblies recently talking about how to keep ourselves mentally and emotionally well, using the five ways to well-being. It has however come to our attention that a lot of children, are having a lot of access to technology that has the potential to harm their wellbeing. Each month we send out an Online safety newsletter, and we will be adding more information from the National Online Safety Centre into our newsletters and Facebook posts over the coming weeks. However, the potential harm to wellbeing does not only lie in apps, games and software. We are concerned about how many children have mobile phones, and how they are using them. What may appear as innocent "group chats" can be really destructive and are a growing concern for us in terms of bullying and affecting learning in school. We do not allow children to have mobile phones in school, but the gossip and unchecked communications outside of school is now starting to affect many children. Please, if you choose to let your child have phones, tablets and other devices, check and supervise their use. Pop software on them that filters harmful content and protects them. Restrict usage so that they are supervised and content is checked. Make sure they do not have the devices overnight on their own, in their room, connected to WiFi without supervision. We teach children to be responsible, ethical, digital citizens in school and do an awful lot of online safety work. As children get older this technology will be at the centre of our society and their lives, so it is super important that we prepare them for it. Have conversations with your children about what is happening in group chats and make sure they understand the seriousness of what they write, so that they realise the impact even small unkind comments can have on other people. We thank you for your support in this matter.
