As teachers, we were quite teary when members of the public came up and shook our hands, and thanked us for bringing the children to London, because it is such an important experience for them all. What an incredible success!

This could not have been achieved without the help of our parent helpers Adrian and Ali, and our teachers giving their time freely. Huge thanks to you all for your dedication and hard work, and thank you to your families for making so many arrangements to manage without you!
