## YR Kapow Celebration Music

Week 1 Lesson 1 Diwali music. Learn about music from another culture. Respond to music through movement.

Week 2 Lesson 2 Hannukah music. Learn the names of some traditional Jewish instruments. Play and move to traditional Jewish music.

Week 3 Lesson 3 Kwanzaa music. Take part in a traditional call and response song. Play "drums".

Week 4 Lesson 4 Traditional Christmas music. Take part in a group song involving singing, voice sounds and instruments. (Carol Service)

Week 5 Lesson 5 Christmas action songs. Suggest appropriate actions for songs. Sing and move to Christmas songs. (Nativity play songs).

## Week 6 Nativity Performance

Vocabulary- Diwali, Hindu, celebration, music, dance, tradition, traditional, Hannukah, jewish, harp, drum, cymbals, tambourine, Kwanzaa, Africa, culture, instrument, call, response, rhythm, beat, Christmas, Christian, sleigh bells, actions, voice sounds, body percussion, perform, performance.

# Y1/Y2 Kapow Tempo- Snail and Mouse

Week 1 Lesson 1 Snail and mouse. Use voices and bodies expressively, while exploring tempo.

Week 2 Lesson 2 Exploring rhyme with snail and mouse. Practise a rhyme using fast and slow beats on instruments.

Week 3 Lesson 3 Singing snail and mouse. Use voices to perform a song with fast and slow beats.

Week 4 Lesson 4 Performing snail and mouse. Use singing voices and instruments to perform a song with fast and slow beats.

Week 5 Lesson 5 The story of snail and mouse. Demonstrate fast and slow beats within the context of a story.

## Week 6 Nativity Performance

Vocabulary- tempo, pulse, beat, fast, slow, singing voice, speaking voice, warm up.

#### Y3/4 Kapow Body and tuned percussion- Rainforests.

Week 1 Lesson 1 – Pitter patter raindrops. Identify structure and texture in music.

Week 2 Lesson 2- Rainforest body percussion. Use body percussion.

Week 3 Lesson 3- Rhythm of the forest floor. Create musical rhythms using body percussion.

Week 4 Lesson 4- Loopy rainforest. Create simple tunes.

Week 5 Lesson 5- Sounds of the rainforest. Build and improve a composition.

# Week (6) Carol Service

Vocabulary- body percussion, combine, compose, contrast, contrasting rhythms, dynamics, inspiration, layers, loop, melody line, organisation, pitch, record, repeated melodies, rhythm, sections, structure, tempo, texture, tune, tuned percussion.

Week 1 Lesson 1– Soundtracks. Appraise different musical features in a variety of film contexts.

Week 2 Lesson 2 – Scenes and sounds. Identify and understand some composing techniques in film music.

Week 3 Lesson 3 – Following the score. Use graphic scores to interpret emotions in film music.

Week 4 Lesson 4 – Composing for film. Create and notate musical ideas and relate to film music.

Week 5 Lesson 5 – The soundtrack. Play a sequence of musical ideas to convey emotion.
