The government has made it clear to schools that parents have a legal duty to ensure their child is at school regularly, absence figures of



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less than 90% are classed as persistent absence and the local authority takes action on this. Finally, thank you so very much for all your efforts this week. The children look so smart and they are in at 8.30 ready for learning, and this is down to your incredible efforts kitting them out and chevvying them along in the morning.
